N.C.I.S. (Newman Center In Summer)

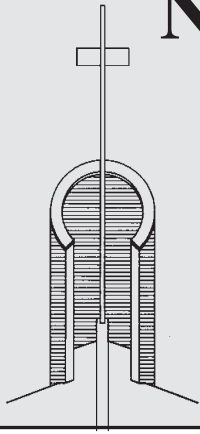
