Our Priest Director

Fr. Jeff Belger accepted the role of Priest Director in 2018. Prior to 2018, he served as Priest Campus Minister at the Center as well as Parochial Vicar at St. Mary of the Visitation parish in Iowa City.

Fr. Jeff began his discernment to the priesthood while a student at Notre Dame High School in Burlington, IA. Prior to the priesthood, he worked as a YMCA Program Director and then as a teacher and Youth Minister at his alma mater. He earned both his MA and MDiv in Theology at St. Meinrad School of Theology.

What is the Friends in Faith Commitment?

You choose your level of committment of at least \$1,000 per year for a pledge term of three years. You may designate where you would like your gift to be utilized, however, at least 25% of your pledge must be designated to our Annual Fund. Our Annual Fund allows the Newman Center Board to use funds where most needed at any particular time. At the end of three years, you will have an opportunity to recommit to Friends in Faith.



Gold Crown Circle

\$10,000 or more annually for three years



Silver Dove Circle

\$9,999 - \$5,000 annually for three years



Bronze Keys Circle \$4,999 - \$1,000 annually for three years

You may determine how you would like to fund your pledge: monthly, bi-monthly, quarterly, bi-annually, or annually. Once your pledge schedule is confirmed, we will send you a reminder when your pledge payment is due. You may pay by check, or we can set up recurring automatic gift using your credit/ debit card or your checking/savings account.
