

Catholic Studies Scholarship Application 2024-2025

Purpose:

The Catholic Studies Scholarship is awarded to students who have expressed an interest in Catholic studies. This Scholarship provides students the opportunity to do research and present on Catholic topics. There are two options:

- 1. Students choose a Catholic topic that intersects their education, intended profession, or the culture.
- 2. Students choose the topic of one of the two major speakers at the Newman Center for the coming year. This year the two topics are: Care for Creation (September) and Flannery O'Connor (March).

Qualifications:

Must be a UI college student in good standing.

Requirements:

- 1. Meet with advisor of your research
- 2. Prepare presentation (plan for 45-60 minutes for presentation and audience participation)
- 3. Cite references used

Scholarship:

Upon completion of the proposed research and presentation the Catholic Studies Scholar will receive a scholarship of \$500 paid directly to the UI student account at the end of the semester in which they complete their work. Up to two scholarships will be granted per semester, four total for the academic year.

- 5. Do you prefer to present in the fall or spring semester?
